

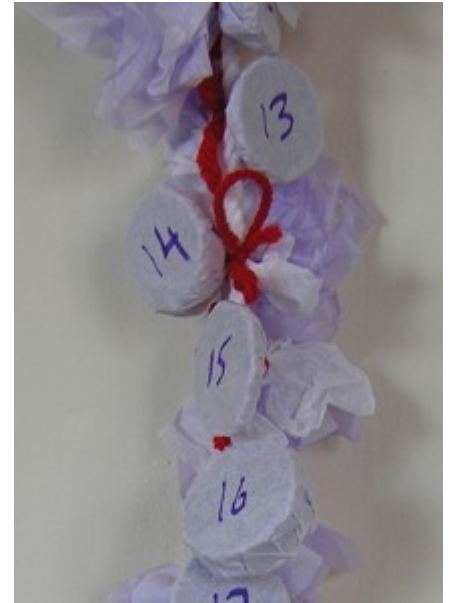
Chocolate Coin Counter

Supplies:

- a. 49 chocolate coins
- b. Tissue paper
- c. Yarn
- d. Glue
- e. Marker

Directions:

- a. Take chocolate coins and cover with tissue paper
- b. Number the coins 1-49.
- c. String them together using glue and yarn.
- d. Each day remove the corresponding number of the day in the omer.



Omer Mountain

Supplies:

- a. Construction paper
- b. Brown bag (cut into a shape of a mountain)
- c. White square stickers
- d. Markers
- e. Glue
- f. 2 Gold lammee stickers



Directions:

- a. Paste the mountain onto the construction paper.
- b. Stick the squares onto the mountain in an ascending order.
- c. Label each square with a number 1-49.
- d. Stick the 2 gold lammee stickers on the top (to represent the luchot).
- e. Each day, color in the box corresponding to the number on that day.

Omer Sheet

Supplies:

- a. Large felt sheet
- b. Small squares of felt
- c. Glue
- d. Markers
- e. Lolly pops

Directions:

- a. Hang the large felt sheet on the classroom door.
- b. Glue on the small squares to form a pocket.
- c. Number the pockets 1-49.
- d. Put a lollypop in each pocket.
- e. Eat the lollypop to correspond with the day of the omer.
